

# **Pinkalicious Tea Party**

Pinkalicious Parties work best immediately after the performance or in between the first and second performance. Actors arrive shortly after curtain and stay for a maximum of 20 minutes. Meet and greet between multiple shows require that actors have a least a 30 minute meal break in between shows and be release at least 30 minutes before next performance time; schedule at least 1 hour and 30 minutes in between multiple performances.

Timing must be confirmed during your advance call. Stage Manager reserves the right to limit or adjust meet and greet schedule if a venue does not adhere to these guidelines.

Meet and greet work best in a designated room or space. Set up tables and chairs for kids and chaperones. Provide activities for kids to participate in while waiting for photos. Fun ideas and coloring sheet follow the link below. For optimal organization, an adult staff member from the venue calls the kids up table by table to a designated location for photos with the characters. Any drinks should be left on the tables and any snacks or food should be served as each table returns from the meet and greet to avoid any food or drink spills on the characters costumes

<u>Decoration Ideas:</u> Pink tablecloths, Pink cups and plates, Pink flowers, Pink streamers, Pink Balloons, All things Pink!

<u>Food Ideas:</u> Pink cupcakes (Some venues choose to have kids decorate their own cupcakes), Pink lemonade, Pink treats

<u>Craft Ideas:</u> Make your own crown, Pinkalicious coloring pages (<a href="http://www.thinkpinkalicious.com/activities">http://www.thinkpinkalicious.com/activities</a>)

<u>Character Appearance:</u> The venue can sets up a backdrop or create some other designated location where the Pinkalicious and Peter characters can sit for photos. An adult staff member gets the kids to form a line to take photos with characters. Then each child or group of children are seated between Pinkalicious and Peter for a sign photos.

- Make pink Popsicles with lemonade or cranberry juice

#### Desserts

 Pink cupcakes with pink frosting (decorate with pink sprinkles and pink candy!)

#### **Decorations**

- Hang pink banners and pink balloons.
- Tie pink ribbons to chairs.
- Place pink tulle over white tablecloth or sprinkle pink glitter on white table cloth.
- Set the table with pink plates and white dollies on top.
